He was the principal investigator of the Multi-Site Evaluation of Children's Advocacy Centers, and has published numerous articles related to CACs. He is the 2018 recipient of the Mark Chaffin Outstanding Research Career Achievement Award from the American Professional Society on the Abuse of Children.
